Foreign Student Policy and Procedures

(Updated 10-25-2009)

Policy 4160-I- E

The custodial or non-custodial biological parent (with durable power of attorney) or legal guardian of the child is not a U.S. citizen or legal resident and resides outside of the United States or its territories.

A non-resident student may attend school in Weber School District if all three of the following conditions are met:

1. The parent or guardian obtains an appropriate visa for the student to attend school;
2. the appropriate foreign student tuition is paid unless subsidized by the state; and
3. the student receives approval to attend school from the Weber School District Foreign Student Coordinator.

Procedures

The Foreign Student Coordinator will work with the Utah State Office of Education (USOE), foreign student agencies, foreign students, host families and the district's high schools to provide a valuable foreign student program.

The coordinator will use the following guidelines:

1. Assign foreign students to district high schools within their requested range (J1 & F1 combined):
Bonneville 4-6
Fremont 4-6
Roy 4-6
Weber 6-8
2. Enroll foreign students only at the beginning of a school year.
3. Limit foreign students to 2 per country per high school.
4. Limit a foreign exchange agency to 2 students per school until May 15th; after that date remaining slots will be given to qualified agencies, regardless of their number of students already placed.
