- A new application must be submitted each school year.
- Before submitting your application, make sure it is completely filled out and all information is correct. No application will be processed unless signed and including last four digits of a social security number. If an incomplete application is received it well be sent back to you, which will delay benefits for your child.
- Only one application per family is necessary.
- Households must report current income on the free and reduced price application.
- Applications will be approved within 10 days from date received by the Child Nutrition Department.
- Until your application is approved by the Child Nutrition Department you are responsible to pay for your students meals at the regular price.
- Applications from the previous year 2017-18 will expire upon the submitting and approval of a new application. If a new application has not been submitted and approved, all benefits will expire on October 3, 2018. You will be responsible to pay for meals that your child/children have eaten.

- Free and reduced applications can be submitted anytime throughout the school year.
