

Nursing Protocol for Human Bite Incident at School

Human Bite Wound Procedures:

- 1. Put on disposable gloves.
- 2. Assess the wound for break in the skin.
- 3. Clean wound with soap and warm, running water, and rinse for 3-5 minutes if skin is broken.
- 4. Apply Bacitracin ointment to the wound. Cover with sterile dressing.
- 5. Apply cold compress.
- 6. Check Hepatitis B and Tetanus immunization status for compliance for both the biter and the person that was bitten if the skin is broken.
- 7. Maintain confidentiality of all involved students and staff.
- 8. Notify administration immediately.

Student Specific Procedures:

- 1. School nurse or adult responsible for student (if nurse is not in the building) will notify student's parents/guardians immediately.
- 2. Urge immediate medical evaluation with a health care provider for both the student that was biting, and the person that was bitten if it is possible there was an exchange of blood or body fluids.
- 3. Complete Report of Human Bite Parent Form, and provide to parent/guardian of affected students.
- 4. Refer parent to administrator regarding behavior if parent requests.
- 5. Record biting incident in electronic health record for both the student who was biting and the person who was bitten.
- 6. Complete Incident Report.

Staff Specific Procedures:

- 1. Advise employee to contact Company Nurse (1-888-375-0279)
- 2. Complete Incident Report

Follow Up Procedures:

- 1. Confer with the administrator and classroom staff to review the context of the biting incident.
- 2. Consider whether changes in supervision and/or environment are needed.
- 3. Evaluate the need for protective equipment, ie arm protection, etc.
- 4. Provide additional staff education as needed.
