### Boundary Exception Appeal Procedure

If your boundary exception request has been denied on the official form, you may appeal that decision with the Boundary Exception Committee. The Boundary Exception Committee considers appeals most Mondays, August through May. If you wish to appeal the school's decision denying your request for a boundary exception, you must call Student Services, 476-7811, before noon Thursday to be considered on the following Monday. The Student Services secretary will get your paperwork from the school and you may also provide additional information in writing if you choose. **All paperwork needs to be received in Student Services by noon on Thursday.**

A Student Services Coordinator will contact you with the decision of the committee as soon as possible. You may also contact the Student Services secretary Monday afternoon for a decision.

The Boundary Exception Committee is the final appeal. If you are not successful in obtaining your request, you may want to consider applying to one of our "Open Enrollment" schools during the early enrollment period (December 1<sup>st</sup> through the 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday in February) for the following school year. You may contact Student Services in December for a list of open enrollment schools.
