Dear Mr. and Mrs. _____:

This letter is sent as notification that your child, _____

- has engaged in disruptive behavior at least 3 times during the school year,
or
- has been suspended at least once for a violation of the Weber School
District Student Conduct Policy (Board Policy 5200) during the school
year.

As per Utah Code (section 53A-11-910), I am required to inform you that if your child engages in disruptive student behavior 3 additional times during the school year, or is suspended a second time during the school year, he/she will be referred to Weber School District's Office of Student Services for a possible referral to Juvenile Court.

The above mentioned section of the Utah Code requires that I direct you to meet with me to discuss your child's disruptive behavior and cooperate with school authorities in correcting the behavior.

- If the notice is written by an assistant administrator or other designee, the appeal is made to the principal.
- If the notice is written by the principal, the appeal is made to the district coordinator assigned to that school.
