SOCIAL SECURITY DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

In order for Weber School District to qualify for and receive substantial continued funding for Career and Technical Education (CTE), it is necessary to obtain each student's Social Security Number. This funding comes from the Carl D. Perkins Vocational Technical Education Act of 1998 and state formula "add on" dollars. These Social Security Numbers are used independent of student names or other identifiers, to track the effectiveness of Career and Technical Education programs during and beyond a student's k-14 education.

FERPA protects the privacy of student educational records and requires schools to minimize collection and use of student Social Security Numbers. Social Security Numbers should be collected only for the purpose of processing student data, employment, federal and state reporting guidelines, and to meet other legal obligations. Weber School District shall not display student Social Security Numbers on public listings of grades, class rosters, student ID cards, student directories, or anything else unless specifically authorized or required by law.
