

NOTICE THAT WEBER SCHOOL DISTRICT CONSIDERS
“BLACK MAMBA”
TO BE AN IMITATION CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE

Weber School District is concerned about a drug that has gained popularity in our community that reportedly gives the similar “high” as that of marijuana. The drug goes by many names, including Black Mamba, Pep Spice, Bliss, Dragon and Bombay Blue (scientific name – Damiana). Weber School District wants to inform students and parents that “Black Mamba” is considered an “imitation controlled substance” and its possession, use, distribution, or sale on school property or while attending a school activity is a violation of Weber School District Policy 5210 *Alcohol and Drug Abuse Policy*. This may result in disciplinary action.
